WESTBROOK - Arthur Joseph "Butch" Gaudette, 58, of Westbrook, passed away unexpectedly in his sleep on Sunday, June 23, 2019.

Butch was born March 1, 1961, in Portland, Maine, the son of Arthur J. Gaudette Sr., and Louise (Malloy) Gaudette. He grew up on Munjoy Hill and attended Portland schools and was a member of Portland High School's Class of 1979.

From his childhood as a Cub Scout and Boy Scout, to his adult life as an avid sportsman, Butch was known for his love of the outdoors.
